## Virginia Assessment Parent Portal Info Sheet



Beginning with the 2022-23 school year, parents will be able to access their students' Growth Assessment and SOL scores and performance details through the new Virginia Assessment Parent Portal.

In order to take advantage of this feature, you must first create an account using a computer or a mobile device. Go to <u>va-results.pearsonaccessnext.com</u> to sign up. Once you have an account, you will need a **claim code** for each testing administration in order to view student data in the account.

After each testing administration, the school will let you know through School Messenger when claim codes are available for pick up. Per the Virginia Department of Education, claim codes are not available through email, a phone call, or able to be sent home with students, but are required to be picked up from the school by a parent or legal guardian. You will need a claim code for each testing administration. The chart below shows the testing administrations for each school level:

You can enter claim codes for more than one student in your account. Once you have the test result from a testing administration, you will not need to enter that claim code again to access the scores. Use the links below the scores to see score explanations.
